OMITTED FROM SUMMARY TABLE ABREU 95V observe an excess of same-sign $\Xi^{\mp} \ell^{\mp}$ events in jets, which they interpret as $\bar{\Xi}_{b} \rightarrow \bar{\Xi}^{-} \ell^{-} \bar{\nu}_{\ell} \mathrm{X}$. They find that the probability for these events to come from non- $b$-baryon decays is less than $5 \times 10^{-4}$ and that $\Lambda_{b}$ decays can account for less than $10 \%$ of these events.

In the quark model, $\bar{\Xi}_{b}^{0}$ and $\bar{\Xi}_{b}^{-}$are an isodoublet ( $u s b, d s b$ ) state; the lowest $\Xi_{b}^{0}$ and $\Xi_{b}^{-}$ought to have $J^{P}=1 / 2^{+}$. None of $I, J$, or $P$ have actually been measured.

## $\Xi_{b}$ MEAN LIFE

This is actually a measurement of the average lifetime of $b$-baryons that decay to a jet containing a same-sign $\equiv^{\mp} \ell^{\mp}$ pair. Presumably the mix is mainly $\bar{\Xi}_{b}$, with some $\Lambda_{b}$.
"OUR EVALUATION" is an average of the data listed below performed by the Heavy Flavor Averaging Group (HFAG) as described in our review "Production and Decay of $b$-flavored Hadrons" in the $B^{ \pm}$Section of the Listings. The averaging procedure takes into account correlations between the measurements and asymmetric lifetime errors.
