Possibly absent in the invariant mass spectrum of the final state  $\pi^+ \pi^- J/\psi(1S)$ in  $e^+ e^-$  collisions. Interpretation as a  $1^{--}$  charmonium state not favored. Isovector hypothesis excluded by AUBERT 05B. A helicity amplitude analysis of the  $X(3872) \to J/\psi \pi^+ \pi^-$  decay gives two possible  $J^{PC}$  assignments:  $J^{PC} = 1^{++}$  and  $2^{-+}$ (ABULENCIA 07E).
